2. How We Use Your Information

- vi. Data is processed by AI, including anonymized user activity, inventory trends, and task completion rates.
 - vii. AI is used to generate processes, such as generating work instructions, predictive analytics for inventory flow, or optimizing operations.
 - viii. user data is anonymized or aggregated before AI processing to ensure privacy.
 - ix. Email Marketing and Targeted Campaigns: Send promotional emails or advertisements based on your preferences.
- 3. Legal Basis for Data Processing
 - a. We process your information based on:
 - i. Consent: When you voluntarily provide information, opt-in to marketing communications, or accept cookies.
 - ii. Legitimate Interests: To improve our services and secure our Site.
 - iii. Legal Obligations: For compliance with applicable laws and regulations.
